

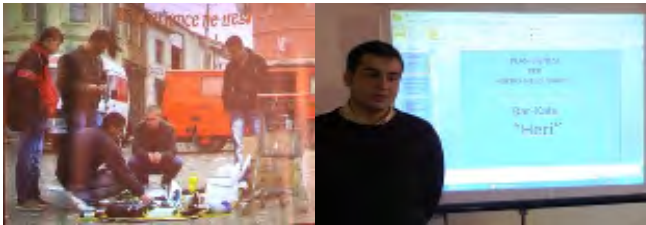

Young Entrepreneurs Project:

- 33 are trained on job skills and 16 are employed through regular jobs or six months internships
- 12 youth is trained on business plans and on presentation skills
- 4 Mentors were engaged to support youth with business plan preparations
- 10 youth are awarded with 130,000 ALL to start their micro-enterprise
- Local partnerships are built with local employment office, municipality, and private companies, and public institutions, who all were engaged to help the youth participants with referrals, employment, mentoring and support.
- Local government of Korca adds 10 start up business to its business assets, which will contribute to modest tax income increase.
- Local government of Korca is recognized in the city as a promoter of youth development.
